

Cookies Policy

When you visit any website, the website may store or retrieve information in your browser, mostly in the form of cookies.

We use cookies on this website. Cookies are small text files that a website installs on your computer/device through which you browse when you access it (the "Cookies"). Cookies allow the website to remember your browsing actions and preferences for a certain period of time and are therefore used by us to process and manage your requests in the most efficient way, as well as to develop and improve our services and the functioning of this website.

This information may be about you, your preferences or your device and is primarily used to make the website work as you expect.

The information does not usually identify you directly, but can provide you with a more personalised web experience.

You have the ability at any time to set your browser to accept all cookies, to notify you when a cookie is issued, or not to receive any cookies at all. How you do this depends on the browser (web browser) you use. Please refer to the "Help" function of your browser. If you accept cookies, they may remain on your computer for many years unless you delete them.

Because we respect your right to privacy, you can choose not to allow some types of cookies. However, blocking some types of cookies may impact your experience of the site and the services we may offer.

The cookies used on this site are as follows:

1. Strictly necessary and functionality cookies

These are cookies installed in order to enable or optimise the functionalities offered by the website and to improve the user's browsing experience.

Currently, these cookies include: **PHPSESSID, xms_user, xms_cookie_set**

2. Analytical cookies

These are cookies installed by tools managed by third parties (Google Analytics, Google TagManager, etc.) to track the quality of the user experience when browsing this website.

Currently, these cookies include: **_gat_UA-12548064-1, _ga, _gid**

3. Third-party cookies

Facebook, YouTube, Vimeo, AddThis, Google Maps and other tools managed by third parties may install cookies for the purpose of sharing content on social networks or for the preparation of consultation statistics. The presence, number and status of these cookies may depend on how the platforms in question are used before or during a visit to this website. It is useful to check what the cookie management policy of these social networks is on their respective websites. We sometimes use third-party web services to display content within our website, for example to show images or videos or to conduct surveys. Similar to sharing buttons for social networks, we cannot prevent these external websites or domains from collecting information about the use made of this embedded content.

Analytical and third-party cookies are controlled by external parties, so it is impossible to guarantee that the list of cookies remains unchanged.

Web browsers allow you to exercise some control of cookies through the browser settings. Most browsers allow you to block cookies or block cookies from specific websites. Browsers can also help you delete cookies when you close the browser. However, you should note that this may mean that any opt-outs or preferences set on the site will be lost.
